



State of New Mexico Vaccine Claim Submission Requirements

Vaccine Coverage and Administration Guidelines:	<p>Effective July 1, 2010, Medco will be administering the prescription drug benefit on behalf of covered lives under several New Mexico plans.</p> <p>The State of New Mexico plans to offer 151,000 of their members coverage for vaccine products and administration only when prescribed and administered by a certified, trained pharmacist who is qualified to prescribe and administer the covered vaccine product and is employed by the contracted pharmacy.</p> <p>The vaccine product and administration must be billed through the <i>TelePAID</i>® System. Any vaccine claim submission that does not meet the specified criteria will be subject to audit recovery.</p>
Action Required for Claim Submission:	<p>The claim submission for the billing of the vaccine product and administration must be billed through the <i>TelePAID</i> System. In addition to the standard billing fields required, the administration fee must be submitted as follows to be eligible for reimbursement:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The vaccine administration fee must be submitted in field # 438-E3, "Incentive Fee Submitted" field, and • The field # 440-E5, "Professional Service Code" field, must be populated with "MA". <p>These are the same fields in use today for vaccine administration billing for other Medco sponsors.</p> <p>Prescribing/administering pharmacist must also submit:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Their <u>pharmacist's</u> NPI number in field # 411-DB "Prescriber ID", and • Use the qualifier of "01" in field # 466-EZ, "Prescriber ID Qualifier" field.
Note:	<p>The vaccine product is not covered if prescribed by the physician and administered by the pharmacist. Administration is covered only when the pharmacist prescribes and administers the covered vaccine.</p> <p>Please speak with your software vendor to ensure your pharmacy's readiness and the required fields are available for claim submission.
